Purpose

The purpose of the Music Director is to help musicians in the church body and the congregation as a whole to grow as disciples of Jesus Christ through worship and music. To lead the congregation of saints in ministry of music that both exalts our God and edifies the saint.

Job Information

Classification:	Salaried; Part-time
Accountability:	First to the Head of the Church, Jesus Christ. The position is also responsible to the Pastor and the Deacon Body.
Work Schedule:	Sunday morning, special services and other times as required. Required time to plan, prepare, rehearse, and lead the members of the music ministry for Sunday morning worship services and other events as planned.
Salary:	7,800/year

Requirements

1. A committed, maturing Christian who has a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
2. Hold to the SBC statement of faith.
3. A proficient instrumentalist on piano and/or guitar to lead musically.
4. Have people and musical leadership skills.
5. Adequate computer skills, including PowerPoint and email.

Responsibilities

1. Direct the organization and implementation of the church music program. This includes, but not limited to:
 - a. Lead weekly and other musical worship as an accompanist on piano or guitar.
 - b. Assist the pastor in planning congregational services of the church.
 - c. Choosing of worship songs for the services.
 - d. Select the arrangements of the songs and music for the services.
 - e. Rehearse with members of the music ministry and assist them in learning and growing in worship—both in leading of the saints and in their individual relationship with God.
 - f. Prepare and submit for the Pastor the order of worship songs and music, and the lyrics for the PowerPoint slide deck each week.

- g. Encouraging and promoting the musical gifts within the body of the church, including vocal and/or instrumental solos or ensembles for the glory of Christ and the edification of the believer and the church.
2. Serve as a leader in the worship services, giving direction to the congregational singing and other phases of worship.
3. Work with the Children's Ministry Director in promoting the development of worship and music ministry for the children and the children to the congregation.
4. Oversee and lead the Choir Director and the Choir as the church music director. This includes, but is not limited, the following:
 - a. Assisting the Choir Director in music decisions for the Choir to minister to the congregation.
 - b. Lead and mentor the Choir Director in musical leadership to both the Choir and the congregation.
 - c. Assist the Choir Director in learning how to be a spiritual leader to those in the Choir—how to spiritually minister to the Choir members.
5. Assist the Pastor and other leaders in creating an atmosphere of worship, reverence, love, and joy in congregational services.
6. Arrange periodic worship and musical ministries to come to MCBC for the edifying of the saints of Powhatan.

Expectations and Goals

1. Mentor musical gifts within the congregation.
2. Mentor the Choir Director in musical leadership.
3. Teach the congregation through leading and by example how to worship our Lord through/in music.
4. Introduce and teach the congregation new worship songs to express their love, devotion, reverence, and thankfulness to our God, and songs of encouragement and edification for one another.
5. Cultivate a unity and vision of the music ministry among those who are a part of the music ministry.
6. Cultivate your ministry gifts.
7. Develop long-term plans and goals of the music ministry of the church.
